

Each collegiate plate will have a motorcycle (MC) plate and a motorcycle personalized (M2) plate. The regular registration fee for a motorcycle plate is \$15.

An additional fee of \$5.00 is due when a metal plate is issued. The net proceeds of the \$5 shall be distributed to the Department of Revenue.

Individual plates are ordered On Demand through the [Plate Reservation and Ordering System \(PROS\)](#). Counties may place bulk orders using the [Alabama Inventory Management System \(AIMS\)](#).

Collegiate car tags (a.k.a., license plates) are available for 26 institutions of higher education in the state of Alabama, and available for four schools from outside the state. All residents of Alabama who are vehicle owners can purchase these tags. You purchase the tags at your local Department of Motor Vehicles. License plates supporting in-state schools cost an additional \$50, with \$48.75 of that money going to the school, and the remaining \$1.25 going to the county. Thus, these fees represent a charitable contribution from the purchaser to the general scholarship fund of that institution and are tax deductible. Plates for out-of-state schools also cost an additional \$50, but most of that money (\$46.25) goes to the Alabama General Fund. No money goes to those schools. The University of Alabama receives almost half of all of the collegiate tag purchases, and combined with Auburn University the two schools claim nearly four-fifths of sales.

The State Comptroller's Office reported a total of \$9,505,940.58 was dispersed to Alabama institutions for 2015-16 tag sales. The University of Alabama sales resulted in \$4,760,431.64 going to the Capstone. Auburn University received \$2,963,415.46. Over the history of this program, which began in 1988 through 2015-16, a total of \$128,412,422.82 have been distributed to in-state schools. The University of Alabama leads in revenue received with \$56,125,554.73, followed by Auburn University with \$44,551,800.

## Car Tag Revenue by Fiscal Year



Collections run from October through September, which represent Tags sold September through August. However, any given month a county or counties may be later on their remittance and the collections roll to a subsequent month (and if in October another year). Also, credit card fees and local legislative deductions are withheld from remittance from certain counties which reduces the amount remitted to our office. If UA tags are purchased with credit cards in counties like Montgomery this can have an impact of the actual dollar amount you will receive. It is important to note that number of tags sold per Revenue from January to December will not easily reconcile against collections received by Comptroller for October through September for the possible late remittances and credit card and local legislative deductions.



# Blob Tag

Grade Level: K-6

Skills Developed: Teamwork, cooperation, locomotor and non-locomotor skills, and spatial awareness.

Equipment Needed: None

## How to Play:

Designate a playing area with clear boundaries - this game can be played in any large open space, indoors or outdoors.

- > Choose 2 students to be the blob ("it"). These two students will hold hands and work together to try and tag other players.
- > The rest of the players scatter around the playing area.
- > On the signal, the blob will attempt to tag other players.
- > When a player gets tagged, they must attach themselves to the blob by joining hands with someone on the blob.
- > As more players get tagged, they must attach themselves to the blob. The more players that get tagged, the bigger the blob gets. *(The blob is essentially a chain of students joined by their hands - only the two students on the end can do the tagging)*
- > The object of the game is to be the last player captured by the blob.

## A Few Rules to Remember:

1. Only the end players of the blob can tag other players.
2. The blob must remain connected to tag other players.
3. No tugging on arms - really emphasize the point of teamwork and cooperation. If players don't work together the game won't work.
