MINUTES OF THE ALAIR ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING Friday, April 21, 1995

The annual business meeting of the Alabama Association for Institutional Research was held on Friday, April 21, 1995, at Troy State University at Dothan during the Association's annual conference.
