

Guidelines for Selection of Best Presentation for the AIR/SAIR Category of "Best Presentations from State Conferences"

- Selection shall be made by the ALAIR Executive Board based on the recommendation of the Awards Committee, chaired by the ALAIR Past-President.
- 2. Presenter must be a current member of ALAIR with no outstanding registration fees and able to attend the AIR Forum or SAIR Conference.
- 3. If an Awards Committee member is nominated for Best Presentation, he or she shall be excluded from serving on the Awards Committee.
- 4. Presentation must have been made at the ALAIR Annual Conference or at other conferences sponsored or co-sponsored by ALAIR.
- 5. Preferential consideration shall be given to presentations that have not been previously presented.
- 6. Presentations shall be evaluated on the following points, based on Executive Board appraisal and conference evaluation ratings:
 - quality of content;
 - effectiveness of presentation;
 - contribution to the area of Institutional Research or Assessment; and
 - appropriateness of the presentation for the AIR Forum or SAIR Conference.

Only one "Best Presentation" is awarded per ALAIR Annual Conference. The award amount is \$300 per person, with a maximum of \$600 per presentation. The check is awarded <u>after</u> the presentation has been made at the AIR Forum or SAIR Conference by submitting proof of presentation (i.e., copy of the session in the program) to the ALAIR Treasurer.
